## Portable Appliance Testing

Portable Appliance Testing or its abbreviated term PAT Testing, is carried out to confirm the integrity of individual items of equipment. This procedure is completed using specialist instrumentation along with a visual inspection to deem the item as a *Pass* or *Fail* for serviceable use.

Appliances requiring testing principally fall into 4 main categories:

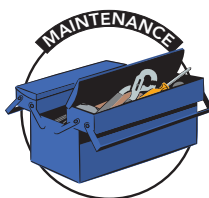
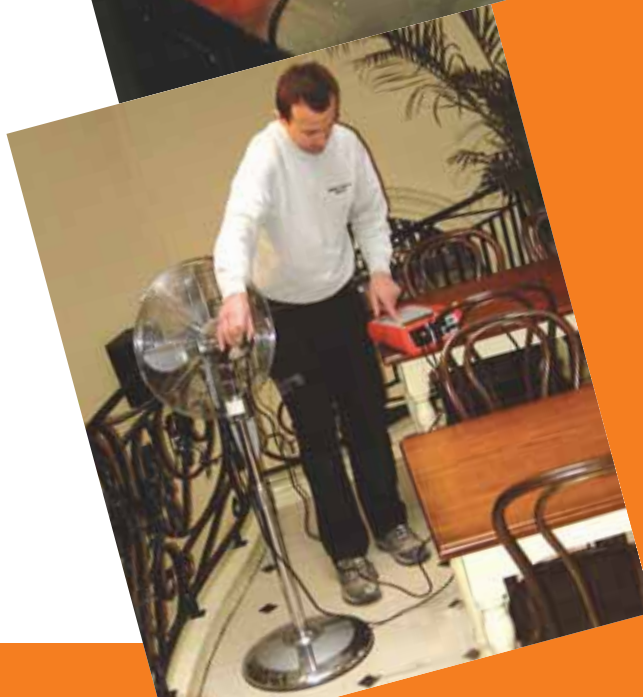
1. Where used by employees
2. Where the public may use ie; schools, shops, hotels, hospitals, rented accommodation etc
3. Where items are sold
4. Where items are repaired or serviced

Upon completion of testing an item should clearly display either a **Green Pass** or **Red Failed** label stating the date of test.

Amber Property Services carries out PAT testing for a range of clients either as a one off instruction or on a regular basis ensuring their compliance with regulations.

An example of this electrical maintenance is a restaurant & wine bar where scheduled testing is completed to ensure the equipment (which has heavy usage) remains in suitable condition for use by staff and/or customers. The testing programme dates, asset register and certificates of conformity are managed by Amber and forwarded to premises owners as required.
